➤ STATUTES/ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO ACADEMICS/EXAMINATIONS

Mumbai University examination rules for 2024-2025, governed by the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 and



updated ordinances, focus on a 75:25 or 60:40 (External:Internal) assessment model, strict unfair means policies (Ordinance 0.5050), and credit-based systems. Key 2024 guidelines include specific grace marks (up to 10) for single-subject failures (Ordinance 0.5042) and mandatory 20-minute pre-exam reporting. [📄](#)

Key Mumbai University Exam Policies (2024-2025)

- **Unfair Means (Ordinance 0.5050):** Strict penalties apply for copying or malpractice, investigated by specialized committees.
- **Passing and Grace Marks (Ordinance 0.5042):** If a student fails in one subject, up to 1% of aggregate marks or 10 marks (whichever is less) can be condoned.
- **Assessment Structure:** Evaluation includes 75% marks for semester-end exams and 25%

- **Assessment Structure:** Evaluation includes 75% marks for semester-end exams and 25% for internal assessments (10 marks for test, 15 for specific mode).
- **Promotion Rules:** Promotion to the next year often requires passing in at least 50% of heads or having a backlog of maximum 9 credits.
- **Examination Conduct:** Candidates must report 20 minutes early, and electronic devices are prohibited. [📄](#)
